## 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019

### Entry Form



There are a lot of changes happening for the show this year, several sections are moving within the showground and there are changes to budgets, tickets and other organisation processes. The Vintage Area is on the move again to an even bigger space in the south-west corner of the showground. On entering the showground via the main gate head straight to the bottom end and turn right and we'll be between livestock and cattle. The other major change is that entry tickets will now be all weekend wrist bands which the show office will post out directly to exhibitors - this means **you need to return the entry form by the closing date August 16th** so that these can be passed to the show office and wrist bands and vehicle entry cards can be posted out - note that **anyone not completing a form or not returning it by the closing date will not get entry passes and will not be able to access the showground.**

There is a show theme around foraging so equipment along these lines is welcome. The Vintage Area will also celebrate 70 years of County Tractors and 90 years of Roadless with a special display. Other tractors are welcome, but in the interests of keeping it a demonstration of how these machines worked we ask all exhibitors to also bring an implement - if you cannot bring an implement then please send your entry form and we will provide a suitable implement for your tractor.

**Lorry parking and camping will be in the red area which is just the other side of the hedge from the Vintage Area, yet outside of the showground** so wrist bands will be needed for exit/entry via the Newbury Building Society entrance. As per usual **all exhibits are to be dropped off the week before the show until 10pm on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September.** On the Sunday will we be able to exit via the red area gate behind our
